CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so let me wrap up our day. I am going to now do our Legal Agenda. So we will be doing our Legal Agenda.

The first matter on our Legal Agenda is the review of ANC-3D's request that the Board terminate the settlement agreement between Millie's, ANC-3D and the Group of Five or More.

I make a motion that we deny this
request. Is there a second?
MEMBER SHORT: Second.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has seconded the motion.

All those in favor say aye.
ALL: Aye.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed? The matter passes 5-0-0.

The second matter on our agenda is the review of settlement agreement dated September 5, 2018 between Petworth Cigars and ANC-4C. Petworth Cigars, License No. 110934.

I make a motion that we approve with modification. Is there a second?

MEMBER CATO: Second.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato has seconded the motion.

All those in favor say aye.
ALL: Aye.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed? The matter passes 5-0-0.

The next matter is the review of a settlement agreement dated September 25, 2018 between ANC-3/4G and The New ACD, License No. 110576.

I make a motion that we approve this request. Is there a second?

MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein has seconded the motion.

All those in favor say aye.
ALL: Aye.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
The matter passes 5-0-0.

We now move to our Supplemental Legal Agenda.

The first matter on our Supplemental Legal Agenda is the review of a Group of Five or More's request for reinstatement of its protest. Cube \& Bale, LLC t/a Sandbox Restaurant, License No. 110062.

I make a motion that we deny this request. Is there a second?

MEMBER SHORT: Second.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has seconded the motion.

All those in favor say aye.
MEMBER CATO: Aye.
MEMBER ALBERTI: Aye.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Aye.
MEMBER SHORT: Aye.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
Anyone abstaining?
MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Abstain, Mr.
Chairman.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
has abstained and the matter passes $4-0-1$ with Mr. Silverstein abstaining.

Yes, sir?
MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Mr. Chairman, this is a difficult issue for me personally. The protestant in this case asked that the hearing be moved because it conflicted with the Jewish high holiday of Yom Kippur. The protestant emailed to request a change and was advised that there was consent of the applicant required.

The applicant in that case denied, but the protestant did not follow-up with the Board. I do not believe that -- I do believe that the failure to follow-up is the fatal flaw here. It is a difficult situation, but had the person simply called and said this was the state of play, we would have had the opportunity to rectify this.

He did not and we were unable to do so. It is extremely unfortunate, but that was the failure there. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, Mr.

Silverstein. I just wanted this case for the record, the protestant had requested -- had stated that because it was a religious holiday at the Roll Call Hearing, that they might not be able to attend.

The protestant from that group was specifically given instruction to contact the legal to get further instructions. The protestant did contact legal. Legal told -informed him that he needed to get the consent of the additional parties. He did reach out, the protestant did reach out to the other parties. The other parties denied his request.

We had the hearing. The protestant
was not here. There was no -- the protestant did not inform the Board that he could not -- that neither him or the missing members of his group could not appear based on a religious observation.

The protestant basically stated that he did not follow-up. After the other parties denied his request, he dropped the ball. And so
therefore, because the protestant was given specific instructions and what to do and that was not done, from a legal perspective, the Board has no choice but to deny the request.

MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
Thank you.
