3 MS. FLETCHER: Are the parties in the
4 matter of Al Dente? Parties in the matter of Al
5 Dente. This is related to the license renewal.

6 This is Case No. 19-PRO-00073, Golden
7 Eagle, Inc., trading as Al Dente, 3210 New Mexico
8 Avenue, NW, License No. 087728. This is a
9 Retailer Class CR license renewal. Protest
10 issues are adverse impact on peace, order and
11 quiet, residential parking and vehicular and
12 pedestrian safety, and real property values.

13 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
14 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent.

15 Introductions beginning with the
16 Applicant, please?

17 MR. MINORA: Matthew Minora from the
18 law firm of Mallios & O'Brien. We're ABC
19 licensed counsel for the Applicant.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Minora, could you
21 spell your name for the record, please?

22 MR. MINORA: Sure. The last name is

1 M-I-N-O-R-A.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

3 MR. MINORA: You're welcome.

4 MS. FLETCHER: And present on behalf
5 of the Spring Valley Wesley Heights Citizens
6 Association?

7 MR. KREBS: William Krebs, K-R-E, B as
8 in boy, S as in Sam.

9 MS. FLETCHER: The first name was
10 William?

11 MR. KREBS: William.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

13 MR. SMITH: And Thomas Smith.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Thomas Smith? Thank
15 you, Mr. Smith. Mr. Smith, you're with the
16 association as well?

17 MR. SMITH: Yes. Mr. Krebs is the
18 first vice president; I'm the treasurer.

19 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay. Thank you.
20 The Spring Valley Wesley Heights Citizens
21 Association has standing as a Protestant. I see
22 that you had the meeting, invited the Applicant,

1 gave them seven days notice and that the
2 Applicant actually attended the meeting. Okay.
3 Thank you.

4 We need to set a date for mediation,
5 a status hearing and a protest hearing. I'll
6 give you the dates for the status and protest
7 hearings first.

8 The status hearing is set for
9 September 18. September 18 at 9:30 for the
10 status hearing.

11 The protest hearing is set for October
12 23 at 4:30. That's October 23 at 4:30 for the
13 protest hearing.

14 We need to set a date for mediation.
15 I'll give you the next available day. The next
16 available day for mediation is Tuesday, August 6
17 at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 12:00, 1:00, 2:00 in the
18 afternoon.

19 MR. SMITH: If we could do something
20 like -- did you say 10:00?

21 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

22 MR. SMITH: 10:00? Something around

1 that, that would be good.

2 MR. MINORA: I think it would be
3 better actually if we could do -- if you could do
4 later, like even noon. Is that all right with
5 you as well?

6 MR. SMITH: Yes, we could do that.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Noon? Okay.

8 MR. SMITH: Is that okay with you,
9 Bill?

10 MR. KREBS: Yes, I think so. I just
11 need to --

12 MS. FLETCHER: Would 1:00 work for
13 anybody?

14 MR. MINORA: We could do 1:00 p.m. as
15 well, if it works for them.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Would 1:00 work, Mr.
17 Smith and Mr. Krebs? 1:00 on --

18 MR. KREBS: I think so.

19 MS. FLETCHER: -- August 6?

20 MR. SMITH: What day of the week is
21 that?

22 MR. KREBS: Tuesday.

1 MR. SMITH: Tuesday.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Is that good?

3 MR. KREBS: Yes.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Mediation is set for
5 Tuesday, August 6 at 1:00. This is related to
6 the license renewal.

8 MR. SMITH: No.

9 MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing
10 is concluded.
