The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Our next case
4	is a fact-finding hearing, case number
5	18-CMP-00240, Allure Lounge, license
6	number 108303. Will the parties please approach
7	and identify themselves for the record, please.
8	(Off-mic comments.)
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No. The table
10	right there, sir. You can take a seat. You can
11	sign in your name and please, again, identify
12	yourself for the record and who are you, sir?
13	You can have a seat, sir.
14	All right. This is a fact-finding
15	hearing because there is some concern that we
16	have. I'm going to have Mr. Puente, who can talk
17	about the report, and then we can have you
18	address some of the concerns that were raised.
19	Okay? Go ahead, Mr. Puente.
20	MR. PUENTE: Yes. So, on Saturday,
21	October 13, 2018 ABRA received a hotline
22	telephone call from MPD about loud noise

emanating from 711 H Street, NE.

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2	Myself and Supervisory Investigator
3	Jason Peru responded. We contacted the Fire
4	Marshal's office, as well, to respond, as well as
5	DCRA, because the MP officer had concerns about
6	the establishment and the way they've been
7	operating in the weeks prior.
8	We arrived on the establishment, we
9	were met by Mr. Amente and Ms. Goodwin.
10	Ms. Goodwin had a one-day temporary license for
11	that entire weekend. It was coinciding with the
12	H Street Festival that weekend, as well.
13	We walked in, we observed numerous
14	safety issues. Drywall was removed, cut out of
15	multiple locations, utility closets were being
16	used as storage areas, the rear exit door did not
17	have a clear means of egress, trash and debris on
18	the rooftop, running exposed wires into three
19	outlets, improper use of extension cords, no fire
20	extinguisher onsite, no code panel located under
21	stairwell, illegal construction, as well as
22	illegal rooftop deck added for DCRA.

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1	DCRA Inspector Manning and Fire
2	Inspector Pennington talked with each other and
3	agreed that they needed to shut down the location
4	for the entire weekend.
5	They couldn't locate no permits,
6	couldn't locate no C of O, BBL, no permits for
7	any of the construction. So, we advised
8	Mr. Amente, Ms. Goodwin, that they needed to get
9	into compliance with DCRA, as well as the Fire
10	Marshal's Office.
11	I returned to ABRA, conducted an ABRA
12	records check and determined that on March 19,
13	2018 a letter was sent to Allure Lounge advising
14	them that they needed to submit a C of O and BBL
15	to ABRA before issue of an ABC license.
16	They were approved by the Board but
17	contingent upon those documents being submitted.
18	On March 31, 2018 we sent another letter advising
19	them that we still needed the C of O.
20	As of today, the report, when it was
21	submitted, ABRA has not received any of those
22	documents. I was advised on Monday, October 15th

1	that DCRA was opening up a legal construction
2	case against the establishment.
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,
4	Mr I'm sorry, Mr. Amente?
5	MR. AMENTE: Yes.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, you were
7	provided on March 31st you were asked to
8	provide us with a certificate of occupancy so we
9	can issue a license. So, where are we? What's
10	going on here?
11	MR. AMENTE: So, I was working on
12	it the C of O it's been for a year and
13	seven months. The guy who
14	MEMBER ALBERTI: Please speak up and
15	into the microphone, sir.
16	MR. AMENTE: Yeah. The person who was
17	doing my paperwork, his name is Russell. And he
18	must not been doing my paperwork.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any what?
20	MR. AMENTE: He didn't do right away.
21	So, there was some document missing that I didn't
22	know. I used to live in Phoenix, so I gave him

all the contracting.

2	He just I don't know really all
3	about it. I came back on September and I start
4	over. I do have all the permits the building
5	permits and the inspection that I passed. And I
6	just got my C of O on Monday this Monday.
7	And the day when they came, they came
8	as Allure was open, but was Allure wasn't
9	exist that day. It was one-day event. In the
10	admission about illegal construction, I do have
11	my paperwork. It wasn't illegal construction.
12	There were yes, the trash on the
13	roof deck because there was some work in there.
14	And they found some drywall cut out by the
15	kitchen, which was I didn't pass inspection in
16	the kitchen.
17	It was conditional certificate from
18	the kitchen to the door. I do have the paperwork
19	for that, too. Yes, there was wiring mistakes
20	that I do believe that is what - I take
21	responsibility for that.
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But let me just

say this, and just as an FYI. Why your name was 1 2 mentioned, you were there a one-day license. So, how could the license be issued, or how was the 3 4 permits -- well, how was your business operating 5 that day and there is no certificate of occupancy? 6 So, I went to DCRA before 7 MR. AMENTE: 8 my -- that was my wife idea. And I went to the 9 DCRA to get a BBL. They're asking me if I'm selling any food. I said, no. They said, you 10 11 don't need any BBL. 12 I came to ABRA and I applied for one, 13 the permits, and they give it to me. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, but --15 MR. AMENTE: The paperwork that I 16 submitted --17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But I'm -- I'm 18 Go ahead, Mr. Puente. sorry. 19 MR. PUENTE: When Ms. Goodwin 20 submitted the application for the one-day, she submitted a C of O for the old location that used 21 22 to be there, which was Liberty Tax Service, which

DCRA Fire said was not -- that event being there 1 2 that night was not allowed to be on that C of O because there was no occupant mode. 3 It was just for the old business from 4 5 2000 -- early 2000s. So, that was an issue with 6 DCRA that there was no occupant, so no one could really be inside the establishment. 7 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, you're 9 saying that that was your wife, that wasn't you. You had nothing to do with that. 10 11 MR. AMENTE: Yes. I gave her 12 permission. Most of the time I live in Phoenix, 13 so I give her permission and, again, we talked to 14 - here. And they're saying that the Board would not have any issue and give it to me. 15 And two weeks before she had even also 16 17 ABRA and DCRA came -- I forgot their name --18 everything was fine. And this is the second 19 They were outside almost like 40 minutes. visit. 20 I saw them. They're standing. Ι 21 thought I'm doing right. If I thought it was 22 wrong, I would do something. But they were

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1	outside, all the team. And I -
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But they came
3	and they shut down the event. Isn't that
4	correct?
5	MR. AMENTE: Yes.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, how could
7	you be all right if they shut the event down.
8	MR. AMENTE: I'm sorry?
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: How could
10	everything be all right if all these folks who
11	were outside came in and shut the event down?
12	MR. AMENTE: DCRA and ABRA came I
13	think two weeks before on September I have a
14	visit from ABRA and DCRA. I showed them
15	everything and they say the same way I opened.
16	The only mistake that day, we added a
17	fan and the electrician put a direct socket.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What was the
19	difference between the first time they came and
20	when they came a second time?
21	MR. AMENTE: The difference?
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yeah.

1	MR. AMENTE: I just add a fan. And,
2	yes, that was through the electrician.
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, you're
4	saying that you have a certificate of occupancy?
5	Is that correct?
6	MR. AMENTE: Yeah. I just got it
7	Monday.
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so, have
9	you provided that information to ABRA?
10	MR. AMENTE: Yes.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: When did you
12	provide that information to the ABC the
13	Agency?
14	MR. AMENTE: I came Tuesday here to
15	pick up the license and they needed clean-hands
16	certificate. So, I went back and I got
17	everything this morning for that.
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, you
19	provided the Agency with a clean-hands
20	certificate and you also provided the Agency with
21	a certificate of occupancy?
22	MR. AMENTE: Yes. I did all the
-	

things with DCRA and everything. 1 Yes. 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, so your approval. So, it's correct, then, that you 3 4 have provided ABRA with the certificate of 5 occupancy that we've waiting for since March. 6 Correct? Also, I have all 7 MR. AMENTE: Yes. 8 the permits that I missed that day. Yeah, I have 9 it already. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, any 10 11 other -- any questions by any other Board 12 members? Well, I think the major issue, sir, was 13 that the Board came. We had asked you in March 14 to provide a certificate of occupancy, and that was not provided. And it's your representation 15 16 to the Board that you provided this information to the Agency on December 11th. Correct? 17 18 MR. AMENTE: Yes. I got the emails, 19 the paperwork that I didn't receive, the guy --20 my agent --CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What is it you 21 didn't receive? 22

1 The emails. MR. AMENTE: 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What email? The - the C of O. 3 MR. AMENTE: 4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, sir, you 5 have been granted a license. 6 MR. AMENTE: Yes. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, I'm saying, 7 8 you have been granted a license. And if 9 you're -- when you're granted a license, it's your name on the license and it says that you are 10 11 responsible. 12 So, you can't come and say that I 13 didn't get the email. You can't come and say 14 that -- and if your wife is not on the license, you can't come and say that -- is your wife on 15 the license? 16 17 MR. AMENTE: No. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Then, you can't 19 come and say that it was my wife was there that 20 night. Because, as far as ABRA is concerned, 21 it's your name and you are responsible. So, I 22 don't want to hear the argument for -- that I

1	hired this guy and this guy didn't do it.
2	It's you. I don't know who this guy
3	is, and I don't care who this guy is, because we
4	don't know. The only person that we know, it's
5	you, sir.
6	And moving forward, when you have the
7	license, it's you are ultimately responsible
8	for whatever happens. I hope that we don't have
9	the pleasure when your license is granted out
10	we don't have the pleasure of seeing you again.
11	And when I say that, it's never a good
12	thing when folks usually come here. But if you
13	were to come back, I don't want to hear you say
14	it was that guy, I didn't get the notice, because
15	you need to make sure that ABRA has your
16	information. And so, therefore, we're going to
17	contact you because you are ultimately
18	responsible.
19	The license is in your name, it's in
20	your name alone, and you are ultimately
21	responsible for everything that occurs in your
22	establishment, sir. Okay?

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1	MR. AMENTE: I've seen all the emails
2	and everything now and everything's come.
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any other
4	questions that you have, Mr. Puente? Any more
5	comments?
6	MR. PUENTE: Nope.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any other
8	representations, sir? No? With that said, I
9	make a motion that we take no further action on
10	this matter, since the licensee has represented
11	to the Board that he has provided the Agency with
12	the missing documents on December 11, 2018. Is
13	there a second?
14	MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
16	has seconded the motion. All those in favor say
17	aye.
18	(Chorus of aye.)
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
20	The matter passes 4-0-0. Thank you very much,
21	sir, for being here today.
22	MR. AMENTE: Thank you.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And you should 2 get your license, I guess, in due course if you haven't received it as yet. 3 4 MR. AMENTE: I can't 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: If you told --I called you in because we never had 6 all right. 7 it. 8 MR. AMENTE: Yeah. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: But if you gave it to them, they'll let you know when you can get 10 it. 11 12 MR. AMENTE: Okay. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That's not up 14 It's up to you and the folks -- so did to me. you -- who did you give the documents to? 15 16 MR. AMENTE: I cannot pronounce the --17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, whoever 18 you spoke to --19 MR. AMENTE: He's there. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Did they tell 21 you when you're going to get your license? 22 MR. AMENTE: She said go to the

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hearing place. 1 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Go to what? 3 MR. AMENTE: Hearing? CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, then 4 Oh. 5 I guess if it's going to be hearing, then I guess you can go back to the desk and ask them when 6 7 you're going to get it, since we're not taking 8 the action. Have a good day, sir. 9 MR. AMENTE: Thank you. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 11 (Whereupon the above-entitled matter 12 went off the record at 2:11 p.m.) 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21
