ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board received an application filed by Allure Lounge, LLC, t/a Allure Lounge (Applicant) that requests approval of a substantial change to a Retailer's Class CT License. The application was duly protested by Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6C. The ANC requested consolidation of a separate renewal application filed by the Applicant. Furthermore, the Applicant has separately requested a stay of the present matter pending the adjudication of its renewal application. The Board grants the request for a stay, which renders the consolidation request moot.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board, on this 10th day of December 2020, hereby **GRANTS** the motion for a stay of the proceedings pending the adjudication of the Applicant's license renewal. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Parties.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
