ANC 6B did vote to 9 withdraw the protest and support renewal. 10 However, it was contingent upon the receipt of a 11 signed settlement agreement, which is what 12 remains to be received by the Applicant. 13 once that happens, we expect to submit that 14 letter with the -- with a settlement agreement 15 that's excused by both parties. 16 MR. ANDERSON: Well, I am glad to hear 17 So I am going to be so disappointed that I that. 18 don't see you guys in January, but you know --19 (Laughter.) 20 (Simultaneous speaking.) 21 We'll be here in MR. JAYARAMAN: 22 January. 23 MR. ANDERSON: At least on this case. 24 But I'll get over it. But I mean, in all 25 seriousness though, I -- I always support parties
