ORDER RESCINDING APPROVAL OF ABRA LICENSE NO. ABRA-109015

Ana Salvadorean & Mexican Food, LLC, t/a Ana Salvadorean & Mexican Food (Applicant), filed an Application for a Retailer's Class CR License (Application) at 3211 Georgia Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. The Application was approved under Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR) § 405.1, which authorizes the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) to issue a license to an applicant that lacks a certificate of occupancy for the premises so long as the applicant satisfies the requirements of Title 23 of DCMR 405.1.

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that the Applicant has failed to renew its license and pay the license fees for its License No. ABRA-109015. Specifically, despite written notice, the Applicant failed to renew its license and pay the license fees by July 12, 2022, the deadline for all Retailer's CR licenses.

Therefore, on this 15th day of February 2023, the Board **RESCINDS** approval of Ana Salvadorean & Mexican Food, LLC's Application, License No. ABRA-109015. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
