ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTESTS

The Application filed by Crujiente, LLC, t/a Anejo Bar & Grill (Applicant), for a Substantial Change to add dancing to its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on March 28, 2022.

On March 28, 2022, the Board dismissed the Protests of Daniel E. Alexander, Adrienne Morris, and Steve Donahoe. Specifically, Mr. Alexander is not an abutting property owner; and Ms. Morris and Mr. Donahoe did not claim to be, nor are they, abutting property owners. D.C. Official Code § 25-601(1)(A)).

Mr. Alexander, Ms. Morris, and Mr. Donahoe may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

ORDER

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
