**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND  
REINSTATING LICENSE**

---

On December 30, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-091137 held by We Are 4 Partners LLC, t/a Arcuri (Petitioner), because the Petitioner had ceased operations. *See* Board Order No. 2021-902.

On January 19, 2022, Adam Hildebeitel, on behalf of the Petitioner sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-091137. In support of his Request for Reinstatement, Mr. Hildebeitel stated that the Petitioner intends to transfer the license to Famiglia P Pizzeria, LLC once it is reinstated.

In addition, Daniel H. Koffman, Esq., on behalf of the successor Licensee, Famiglia P Pizzeria, LLC, submitted a Motion to Reconsider Order Cancelling License. In support of his Motion to Reconsider, Mr. Koffman stated that Famiglia P Pizzeria, LLC submitted a Transfer Application on January 26, 2022 and it is ready to open and start operating its business soon. Famiglia P Pizzeria, LLC requests that the Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-091137 be reinstated and allowed the Transfer Application process to continue.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 9th day of February 2022, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against We Are 4 Partners LLC, t/a Arcuri, by the Board on December 30, 2021, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Retailer's Class CR License ABRA-091137 be **REINSTATED**.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
