3 AGENT FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of Aroma, please, come forward? This
5 is Case No. 19-PRO-00017, Brothers Burger Bar,
6 LLC, 707 H Street, N.E., License No. ABRA-112502.
7 This is a Retailer Class CR new application.

8 The protest issues are adverse impact
9 on peace, order and quiet, residential parking,
10 and vehicular and pedestrian safety and real
11 property values.

12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
13 the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent.

14 Introductions beginning with the
15 applicant, please.

16 MR. MISKIRI: Good morning, Ms.
17 Fletcher. I'm Jeff Miskiri, a partner of
18 Brothers Burger Bar.

19 AGENT FLETCHER: And how do you spell
20 your last name?

21 MR. MISKIRI: M-I-S-K-I-R-I.

22 AGENT FLETCHER: M-I-S?

1 MR. MISKIRI: K-I-R-I.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: K-R?

3 MR. MISKIRI: K-I.

4 AGENT FLETCHER: K-I.

5 MR. MISKIRI: R-I.

6 AGENT FLETCHER: R-I.

7 MR. MISKIRI: Yes.

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. And you can
9 have a chair, too. Thank you very much. Yes,
10 hi, if you would just state it and spell it for
11 the record?

12 MR. JONES: Yes, ma'am. Darryl Jones,
13 D-A-R-R-Y-L J-O-N-E-S.

14 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
15 And present on behalf of ANC-6C?

16 MR. KELTY: Yes. My name is
17 Commissioner Joel Kelty, 6C05.

18 AGENT FLETCHER: And Joel, could you
19 spell your last name, please?

20 MR. KELTY: K-E-L-T-Y.

21 AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
22 ANC-6C has standing as a protestant.

1 We need to schedule a date for a
2 mediation, a Status Hearing and a Protest
3 Hearing. I'll give you the date for the Status
4 and Protest Hearing first.

5 The day for the Status Hearing is May
6 8.

7 MR. MISKIRI: 8, you said?

8 AGENT FLETCHER: Uh-huh, the number 8.

9 MR. MISKIRI: Okay.

10 AGENT FLETCHER: Uh-huh, May 8 at 9:30
11 a.m., that's the Status Hearing.

12 The Protest Hearing is set for June 5,
13 that's June the 5th at 4:30.

14 We need to set a date for mediation.
15 I'll give you the next available day. The next
16 available day for mediation is Tuesday, April 16
17 at 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 1:00, 2:00, pretty much
18 any time that day.

19 MR. KELTY: Tuesday, April 16?

20 AGENT FLETCHER: That's the next
21 available day. If that doesn't work, we can just
22 keep moving through the calendar.

1 MR. KELTY: That works --

2 AGENT FLETCHER: That works for you?

3 MR. KELTY: -- for me.

4 MR. JONES: Do you have anything on
5 that Thursday that you can give?

6 AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, we have
7 something. Oh, just a second. Actually, yeah,
8 that Thursday is kind of iffy, but we can move to
9 the following week.

10 MR. JONES: Well, let's do the 16th in
11 the afternoon.

12 AGENT FLETCHER: The 16th in the
13 afternoon. Would you prefer 1:00, 2:00?

14 MR. JONES: 2:00 work for you guys?

15 MR. MISKIRI: That's fine.

16 AGENT FLETCHER: 2:00 good? 2:00 on
17 Tuesday, April 16 for mediation.

18 Most likely the mediation will take
19 place in this room, but you can just check in our
20 front. If this room is not available, then we
21 will go some place in the back.

22 Any questions at all?

1 MR. MISKIRI: No.

2 AGENT FLETCHER: If you have any
3 beyond today, my card is on the desk and you can
4 feel free to give me a call.

5 Okay. In that case, the Roll Call
6 Hearing is concluded. Thank you for coming.

7 MR. MISKIRI: Thank you.

8 MR. JONES: Thank you.
