MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the matter of Assets please come forward, the parties in the matter of Assets?

This is Case \#19-PRO-00143, Voyager 888, LLC, 1805 Connecticut Ave NW; License \#ABRA-113585. This is a Retailer Class CN License Renewal.

The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet, residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety and real property values.

My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Introductions beginning with the applicant, please?

MR. BIANCO: Good morning, Ms. Fletcher. Richard Bianco. I represent the applicant in this case, Voyager 888. Present and seated to my left is Jeffrey Schaeffer. He is the principal of Voyager 888.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr. Schaeffer, can you spell your last name?

MR. SCHAEFFER: S-C-H-A-E-F-F-E-R.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Mr. Bianco, spell your last name.

MR. BIANCO: B-I-A-N-C-O. And for the record, I did enter a written appearance in this case.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you, Mr. Bianco. Present on behalf of ANC 2B?

MR. SACCO: Peter Sacco. I'm ANC 2B's executive director, S-A-C-C-O.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And on behalf of ANC 2D?

MR. NESTLER: Jeff Nestler, N-E-S-T-L-E-R. I'm the vice chairman of ANC 2D.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Nestler. And on behalf of the Sheridan-Kalorama Neighborhood Council?

MR. FRIEDMAN: Good morning. I'm Donald Friedman, D-O-N-A-L-D Friedman, F-R-I-E-D-M-A-N. I'm president of the SheridanKalorama Neighborhood Council.

We also have the secretary, Marie Drissel, and the treasurer, Doug Labossiere, present.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, if you can state your name and spell it for the record.

MS. DRISSEL: Marie Drissel, M-A-R-I-E D-R-I-S-S-E-L. And I'm secretary of SheridanKalorama Neighborhood Council.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MR. LABOSSIERE: My name is Douglas Labossiere. That's spelled L-A-B-O-S-S-I-E-R-E. And I'm treasurer of the Sheridan-Kalorama Council.

MS. FLETCHER: Douglass, can I repeat the spelling?

MR. LABOSSIERE: Sure.
MS. FLETCHER: I think I may have missed a letter.

MR. LABOSSIERE: I almost got away with it.

MS. FLETCHER: I have L-A-E?
MR. LABOSSIERE: B like Boy.
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, B-O?
MR. LABOSSIERE: Yeah.
MS. FLETCHER: B-O-F-F?
MR. LABOSSIERE: S, S like Sam, two S's like Sam.

MS. FLETCHER: I had it all wrong. Thank you.

MR. LABOSSIERE: That's okay. I'm
used to it.
MS. FLETCHER: S-S-I --
MR. LABOSSIERE: Mm-hmm.
MS. FLETCHER: -- E?
MR. LABOSSIERE: R.
MS. FLETCHER: R-E?
MR. LABOSSIERE: Correct.
MS. FLETCHER: I got it, thank you. Okay, thank you. Just one question for you, Mr. Friedman. The council is incorporated in D.C.?

MR. FRIEDMAN: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. There is also a group of five individuals? Oh, okay. Could you state your name, please, and spell it for the record?

MR. BARTKOWIAK: Name is Adam Bartkowiak, A-D-A-M B-A-R-T-K-O-W-I-A-K. And I'll be the representative as well.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, and we have you as the designated representative for that group of five. Are there any individuals from your group present today?

MR. BARTKOWIAK: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, you can come right up front there and state your name and
spell it for the record.
MS. WILSON-CHAPMAN: Amy
Wilson-Chapman, A-M-Y W-I-L-S-O-N, hyphen, C-H-A-P-M-A-N.

MS. FLETCHER: That's Amy? Spell your last name for me again, please.

MS. WILSON-CHAPMAN: Sorry, W-I-L-S-O-N, hyphen C-H-A-P-M-A-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Got it. Thank you very much. Anyone else from your group today? Okay, thank you.

For your group, Mr. -- may I call you Adam?

MR. BARTKOWIAK: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Adam, your group of five is granted conditional standing today. There are two of you present today, so that's fine.

At the upcoming status hearing three individuals that are not here today would need to appear in-person. The Board likes to see five faces and there are two today. So if there's going to be a status hearing, have the other three people show up in-person.

MR. BARTKOWIAK: Okay.

MS. FLETCHER: Otherwise, the Board may dismiss the protest.

MR. BARTKOWIAK: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: So I've granted conditional standing to your group today.

MR. BARTKOWIAK: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Because you're here and Ms. Wilson-Chapman. Is anyone here from St. Margaret's Episcopal Church?

FEMALE PARTICIPANT: No, Richard isn't. Richard, the Reverend Richard Weinberg is not here. He --

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
FEMALE PARTICIPANT: He's not asking for standing.

MS. FLETCHER: I'll spell his name. For the record, it's Richard, R-I-C-H-A-R-D. His last name is Weinberg, W-E-I-N-B-E-R-G?

FEMALE PARTICIPANT: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. But just for the record, the church did file a protest. And I understand what you're saying, that they're not really seeking standing.

FEMALE PARTICIPANT: Right.
MS. FLETCHER: They did file a protest
so we have to assume that's what they were doing. So what I'm going to say is not going to matter to them, but the protest is dismissed because churches don't have standing as protestants. And so they will get an order dismissing the protest. The church is going to receive a Board order dismissing the protest because they did file a protest, although they are not seeking status or standing as protestants.

But they did file the protest, and so the Board will issue and order dismissing the protest.

FEMALE PARTICIPANT: Thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes. ANC 2B has
standing. The Sheridan-Kalorama Neighborhood Council has standing. The group of five is granted conditional standing.

And St. Margaret's Episcopal Church is dismissed because churches do not have standing, and they're not here today, but churches do not have standing to file a protest.

We need to set a date for mediation, a status hearing and a protest hearing. I'll give you the date for the status and protest
hearing first.
The status hearing is set for March 11, March 11, 2020 at 9:30 for the status hearing.

The protest hearing is set for April
8, April 8 at 4:30 for the protest hearing.
I will give you the next available day for mediation. The next available day is February 25 -- that's on Tuesday -- any time between 9:00 and 2:00. That's February 25.

MR. BIANCO: I have a mediation in Superior Court at 1:30, but the morning is open fully.

MR. SACCO: 9:00 would be best.
MR. FRIEDMAN: 9:00 is fine.
MS. FLETCHER: 9 o'clock?
(Simultaneous speaking)
MS. FLETCHER: So, Mr. Friedman, 9
o'clock?
MR. FRIEDMAN: That's fine.
MS. FLETCHER: So that's Tuesday, February 25 at 9:00 for mediation. Tuesday, February 25 at 9:00.

Everyone has put their contact information on that sign-in sheet? Mr. Nestler,
did you put your contact information on that sign-in sheet?

MR. NESTLER: I put it on the one on that side.

MS. FLETCHER: I'll get it then. I'll find it. That's okay. I know it's over there. I'll get it.

MR. BIANCO: Do you have mine? Do you have --

MS. FLETCHER: If you could put it on there --

MR. BIANCO: I sent a letter, but do you need to put it on --

MS. FLETCHER: You have it in your letter already?

MR. BIANCO: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, I'll get it. Thank you.

MR. BIANCO: I know Ms. Fashwah (phonetic) has it.

MS. FLETCHER: Beyond this point, we communicate with you by email. That's why I always like to make sure. Okay, any questions at all from anybody? Okay, well, the roll call hearing is concluded. Thank you for coming. See
you in February.
