22	what's your relationship with the establishment,

MR. COSTLEY: I'm the general manager.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

Sir, do you have -- are there any preliminary matters? Okay. Can you give that -- can you show that to Mr. Adams, please?

MR. ADAMS: All right. Thank you.

MR. COSTLEY: Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Give that to her, please. All right. So are there any preliminary matters in this case, Mr. Adams?

MR. ADAMS: There are, Mr. Chairman.

The parties have discussed this case and are able to propose an Offer in Compromise for the Board's consideration.

There is a single charge on this case regarding the operation of a summer garden after hours. To resolve that, the parties are proposing a fine in the amount of \$1,500 to be paid within a period of 30 days. If the establishment does not make the payment within the 30-day period, the establishment understands

its license shall be suspended indefinitely until 1 2 the fine is paid. 3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, Mr. 4 Adams. 5 All right. Mr. Costley, it's my understanding that there is an Offer in 6 Compromise. And the Offer in Compromise is that 7 there is a fine of \$1,500 payable in 30 days. 8 9 the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license 10 will be suspended. 11 Is this your understanding, sir, of 12 the Offer in Compromise? 13 MR. COSTLEY: Yes, it is. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 15 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that 16 you are giving up your right to a hearing? 17 MR. COSTLEY: Yes. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also 19 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, 20 that you are giving up your right to appeal this 21 matter? 22 MR. COSTLEY: Yes.

2	this said, I then make a motion that the Offer in
3	Compromise of a fine of \$1,500 payable in 30 days
4	be accepted. If the fine is not payable in 30
5	days, the license will be suspended until the

9	seconded the motion.
