On April 6, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-091333 held by POR JAI, LLC, t/a Bangkok Thai Dining (Petitioner), because the Petitioner requested the cancellation of its license. *See* Board Order No. 2022-149.
