4 is Case No. 17-PRO-00074, Bangkok Thai Dining,
5 License No. 91333.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and
7 identify themselves for the record?

8 Is there anyone here for Bangkok Thai
9 Dining?

10 I will recall this case. What I
11 typically do, I call the cases at 9:30. If you
12 are not here, I will recall the cases again at
13 10:00, which I believe is a reasonable period of
14 time for folks to be here for 9:30 hearings.

15 And if you are not here, then we will
16 dismiss the case.

17 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
18 went off the record at 9:41 a.m. and resumed at
19 9:58 a.m.)

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So
21 let me go back to our calendar to recall all the
22 cases that they were not here. If I call and the

1 party is not here, the Board will be dismissing
2 the protest.

3 So the first case we will be recalling
4 is Case No. 17-PRO-00074, Bangkok Thai Dining.

5 Would the parties, please, approach?
6 Bangkok Thai Restaurant, License No. 1091 --
7 91333.

8 I make a motion that neither the --

9 INTERPRETER: I am the interpreter for
10 that.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You are the
12 interpreter, but --

13 INTERPRETER: For Bangkok Thai.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you know who
15 you were supposed to interpret for? Do you see
16 the person in the --

17 INTERPRETER: Bangkok Thai.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, do
19 you know who --

20 INTERPRETER: No.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

22 INTERPRETER: I don't know them.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You don't know
2 who the person is.

3 INTERPRETER: No.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is there any
5 one in this room for Bangkok Thai Restaurant?
6 No? All right.

7 I make a motion since the -- neither
8 the protestant nor the licensee is here, I make a
9 motion that we dismiss this matter. Is there a
10 second?

11 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: Well --

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr.
14 Alberti?

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- my concern is that
16 -- just one moment, please.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
18 licensee has applied for a license to make a
19 substantial change to their license. This matter
20 was scheduled for a Protest Hearing. The
21 licensee is not here and the protestant is not
22 here.

1 And so therefore, the motion that has
2 been made is that the licensee's application for
3 a substantial change, that this be dismissed.

4 And the protest of this change is also dismissed.

5 Both parties will have 10 days to send some
6 notification to the Board why they were not here
7 today. And the Board will make a determination
8 whether or not we will reinstate the protest and
9 the licensee's application. Is there a second?

10 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second, Mr.
11 Chairman.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
13 has seconded the motion.

14 All those in favor say aye?

15 ALL: Aye.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
17 Those matter passes 6-0-0.

18 So therefore, the licensee's
19 application for a substantial change application
20 for Bangkok Thai Dining has been dismissed. And
21 also the protest has been dismissed. And it is--
22 this case was first called at 9:30 -- at 9:40

1 when I took the Bench. They are not here. It
2 was recalled at now 10:00, they are still not
3 here. So that matter is dismissed.
