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**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND  
REINSTATING LICENSE**

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On November 17, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Manufacturer's Class B License No. ABRA-103291 held by Bardo, LLC, t/a Bardo River Brewery (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to pay the second-year license fees. *See* Board Order No. 2021-763.

On November 24, 2021, Bill Stewart, on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Manufacturer's Class B License No. ABRA-103291. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from submitting its second year license fees have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner pays the second-year license fees.

Accordingly, it is this 1st day of December 2021, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on November 17, 2021, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that its Manufacturer's Class B License No. ABRA-103291 be **REINSTATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Petitioner pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
