The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So,
4	let's start with our show cause hearing (status)
5	calendar.
6	The first case on our show cause
7	hearing (status) calendar is Case No. 18-AUD-
8	00090, Bareburger, License No. 102759.
9	Will the parties please approach and
10	identify themselves for the record, please.
11	MR. SOUSA: Christopher Sousa for the
12	District of Columbia.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
14	Mr. Sousa.
15	MR. MEGALLA: Megalla Megalla for
16	Bareburger Group, LLC.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: What's your
18	relationship to the establishment, sir?
19	MR. MEGALLA: I'm the general manager
20	for this location.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do you have a
22	letter authorizing

1	MR. MEGALLA: I do.
2	(Pause.)
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
4	What's your name again, sir?
5	MR. MEGALLA: It's Megalla Megalla.
6	The first and last name are the same, sir.
7	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh. I wouldn't
8	know they were the same. I was reading and
9	good thing you brought it to my attention,
10	because I would not have had a problem with it;
11	but I was reading the document that's in front of
12	me because it's a little bit different from the
13	authorization that I -
14	MR. MEGALLA: Not a problem.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so, that's
16	why I was while I was reading the document,
17	I'm trying to find out the name of the person and
18	you brought it to my attention.
19	MR. MEGALLA: It's easy to remember.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yeah, and it's
21	not a bad name. I mean that. It's not a bad
22	name.

1	MR. MEGALLA: Thank you.
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Megalla
3	Megalla, that's a nice - it has a good ring to
4	that.
5	MR. MEGALLA: Thank you.
6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ask
7	you if you were married, but that leads to
8	normally, it's apparent because when they call
9	you, they call the name twice. It's like they're
10	mad at you. So, now we don't
11	MR. MEGALLA: I could never get a read
12	on them.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
14	Thank you. And thank you for bringing some love
15	to the first hearing for the day. Thank you,
16	sir.
17	Mr. Sousa, are there any preliminary
18	matters in this case?
19	MR. SOUSA: Yes. There is an Offer in
20	Compromise to present to the Board.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is
22	that, sir?

1	MR. SOUSA: As to Charge 1, the only
2	charge, failure to file the required quarterly
3	statements, that would be a payment of \$2,000
4	within 30 days or the license will be suspended
5	until payment is made.
6	And they've also agreed to submit all
7	pending quarterly statements that are currently
8	outstanding.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any time line
LO	or is it just -
L1	MR. SOUSA: I understand they're going
L2	to do it within the week.
L3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Is
L4	that part of the agreement or -
L5	MR. SOUSA: Yes. Yes.
L6	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, I'm just
L7	saying is it part of the agreement that it was
L8	within a certain time line or just that
L9	MR. SOUSA: Yeah. We can agree to 30
20	days.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. All
22	right. All right.

Mr. Megalla, it is my understanding 1 2 there's an Offer in Compromise, and the offer in compromise is that you are receiving a fine of 3 4 \$2,000 payable within 30 days; and that all the 5 outstanding quarterly statements will also be filed within the next 30 days. 6 Is this your understanding, sir, of 7 the offer in compromise? 8 9 MR. MEGALLA: Yes, sir. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 11 of the fact that in an Offer in Compromise that 12 you're giving up your right to a hearing? 13 MR. MEGALLA: Yes, sir. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also 15 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise 16 that you're giving up your right to appeal this 17 matter? 18 MR. MEGALLA: Yes, sir. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 20 With that said, I then make a motion that the 21 Offer in Compromise of the fine of \$2,000 payable

within 30 days be accepted.

1	If the fine is not paid within 30
2	days, the license will be suspended until the
3	fine has been paid.
4	Also, that all outstanding quarterly
5	statements will be filed within the next 30 days.
6	Is there a second?
7	MR. SHORT: Second.
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
9	seconded the motion.
10	All those in favor say aye.
11	(Chorus of ayes.)
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All those
13	opposed?
14	The matter passes six-zero-zero.
15	And we have Ms. Clark in the audience.
16	If you have any problems filing quarterly
17	statements, sir, the agency will be here to
18	provide you whatever assistance we can to make
19	sure that you comply with the law.
20	MR. SHORT: And Ms. Clark introduced
21	herself before the hearing and we talked about
22	logistics.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Our
2	job is not - the agency's job is not to penalize
3	you, it's to help you.
4	MR. MEGALLA: All right. Thank you.
5	MR. SHORT: Thank you.
6	(Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
7	went off the record at 10:04 a.m.)
