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**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT**

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The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board received a motion for reinstatement from the above-mentioned Applicant. The cancellation of the license was based on the failure to pay required second-year licensing fees, as described in Board Order No. 2020-853, issued on November 18, 2020. The Applicant indicates that the failure to pay the required fees was due to the forced closure of the establishment due to the COVID-19 emergency faced by the District, which interrupted the Applicant's normal business operations. Therefore, the Board on this 31st day of March 2021, hereby **APPROVES** the motion for reinstatement on the **CONDITION** that all monies owed to the agency are paid before the Licensing Division reinstates the license. Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
