ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On November 18, 2020, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class B License No. ABRA-088966 held by Hanmi Corp, t/a Best World Supermarket, because Hanmi Corp failed to renew its license by September 30, 2020. *See* Board Order No. 2020-739.

On November 19, 2020, Young Sook Pak, on behalf of Hanmi Corp (Petitioner), sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class B License No. ABRA-088966. In support of his request for reinstatement, Mr. Pak stated that he submitted the documentation necessary to renew his license and a payment for the license fees.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner renews its license and pays the required fees.

Accordingly, it is this 24th day of November 2020, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Hanmi Corp, t/a Best World Supermarket, by the Board on November 18, 2020, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner renew and pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
