The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Our next case
4	is a Show Cause Hearing, Case No. 18-CIT-00349,
5	Betty's Gojo, License No. 102500.
6	Will the parties, please, approach and
7	identify themselves for the record? I'm sorry,
8	who are you, ma'am?
9	MS. WELDEGEBRIEL: Abeba Weldegebriel.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You are who?
11	MS. WELDEGEBRIEL: Abeba. Abeba.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you a
13	translator or are you with him?
14	MS. WELDEGEBRIEL: Owner.
15	MR. EMBAYE: No, no, we are the
16	owners.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh, no, I
18	apologize. I thought
19	MS. WELDEGEBRIEL: Betty's Gojo.
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh, no, it's
21	the other case that we have the translator.
22	MR. EMBAYE: Oh, sorry, sir.

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I apologize.
2	MS. WELDEGEBRIEL: Oh.
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. All
4	right. Okay. I'm sorry, go ahead, please, yes.
5	MS. GEPHARDT: Okay. Chrissy Gephardt
6	here on behalf of the Office of the Attorney
7	General for the District of Columbia.
8	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good afternoon,
9	Ms. Gephardt.
10	MR. EMBAYE: Kibreab Embaye.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Embaye.
12	MS. WELDEGEBRIEL: Embaye.
13	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Embaye. Good
14	afternoon, sir. Yes, ma'am?
15	MS. WELDEGEBRIEL: Abeba Weldegebriel.
16	Abeba. Abeba.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Right. You see
18	we always start off and then we start off loud
19	and then we trail off.
20	MR. EMBAYE: Okay.
21	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So you have to
22	be consistent. There is a sign-in sheet, make

1 sure that you sign-in, you sign both of your 2 names on the sign-in sheet, please. This is a Show Cause Hearing. 3 4 there any preliminary matters in this case? 5 Yes, there is a MS. GEPHARDT: 6 preliminary matter. The parties have agreed on 7 an Offer in Compromise to be as follows: 8 For Charge 1, for failing to file the 9 required quarterly statement for the first quarter on time, it's an \$850 fine to be paid 10 11 within 30 days. If it is not paid within 30 12 days, the license will be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid. 13 14 And then I also want to make note that 15 the quarterly statement was ultimately fined --16 filed late on June 12, 2018, so it has been 17 submitted. 18 MEMBER SHORT: Good. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: That's it? 20 MS. GEPHARDT: And that's it. 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. is my understanding there is an Offer in 22

1 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that 2 there is a fine of \$850 payable in 30 days. the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license 3 4 will be suspended until the fine has been paid. 5 And it is also my understanding that 6 the late file -- the quarterly statement was subsequently filed. 7 8 Is this your understanding of the 9 Offer in Compromise? 10 MR. EMBAYE: Yes. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 12 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that 13 you are giving up your right to a hearing? 14 MR. EMBAYE: Yes. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 15 Are you also 16 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, 17 that you are giving up your right to appeal this 18 matter? 19 MR. EMBAYE: Yes. 20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said, 21 I then make a motion that the fine of \$850 22 payable in 30 days be accepted. If the fine is

1	not payable in 30 days, the license will be
2	suspended until the fine has been paid.
3	Is there a second?
4	MEMBER SHORT: Second.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
6	seconded the motion.
7	All those in favor say aye.
8	ALL: Aye.
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
10	The matter passes 4-0-0.
11	All right. Thank you. I want to
12	thank the parties for coming to an agreement on
13	this matter. And thank you. I'll have you sign-
14	off on this order.
15	MS. GEPHARDT: Thank you.
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: This decision
17	sheet. Thank you. Have a great day.
18	MS. GEPHARDT: Yes, you, too.
19	(Whereupon, the Show Cause Hearing was
20	concluded at 3:39 p.m.)
