ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PAYAM BAKHAJE’S PROTEST

The Application filed by TM Liquors, Inc., t/a Big Ben Liquors (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer’s Class A License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 28, 2021.

On June 28, 2021, the Board dismissed the Protest of Payam Bakhaje because he failed to provide his mailing address in the protest letter. *See* 23 DCMR § 1602.3. In addition, Mr. Bakhaje did not state a basis upon which standing to file a protest could be granted. *See* D.C. Official Code § 25-601.

Payam Bakhaje may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

ORDER

The Board does hereby, this 30th day of June 2021, **DISMISS** the Protest of Payam Bakhaje. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Parties.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
