Are there any preliminary matters in this case?

MS. PHILLIPS: Thank you for indulging us. The parties have an Offer in Compromise they wish to present to the Board. It's a fine of \$1,100 with 30 days to pay. My understanding is the licensee wants to pay it today. If it is not paid today, the license will be suspended until payment is received.

It is my understanding from the licensee that the third quarter statement was filed late, but it was filed the night the citation was issued.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

Good morning, Mr. Martin. It's my understanding that there is an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that there is a fine of \$1,100 payable today. If the fine is not payable today, then license will be suspended.

1 And it's also my understanding that 2 the outstanding third quarter statement has been filed. 3 4 Is this your understanding, sir, of 5 the Offer in Compromise? 6 MR. MARTIN: Yes, sir. 7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 8 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that 9 you are giving up your right to a hearing? Yes, I do. 10 MR. MARTIN: 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also 12 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, 13 that you are giving up your right to appeal this 14 matter? 15 MR. MARTIN: Yes. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 17 Hearing so, I then make a motion that the Offer 18 in Compromise of a fine of \$1,100 payable in 30 19 days -- I'm sorry, payable today be accepted. 20 That if the fine is not payable, the license will 21 be suspended until the fine has been paid.
