3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The
4 next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-
5 00193, The Arsenal, License No. 90281.

6 Will the parties, please, approach and
7 identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MS. BABIN: Stephanie Babin, General
9 Counsel.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
11 again, Ms. Babin.

12 MS. BABIN: Good morning.

13 MS. SCHMIDT: Good morning. Amy
14 Schmidt, Assistant Attorney General, on behalf of
15 the District of Columbia.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
17 Ms. Schmidt.

18 Are there any preliminary matters in
19 this case?

20 MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there is. There is
21 an Offer in Compromise of a payment of \$2,000
22 made within 60 days. If this payment is not made

1 within 60 days, the license shall be suspended
2 until payment is made.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Ms.
4 Babin, it's my understanding that there is an
5 Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise
6 is that there is a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60
7 days. If the fine has not been paid -- is not
8 paid in 60 days, the license will be suspended
9 until the fine has been paid.

10 Is this your understanding of the
11 Offer in Compromise?

12 MS. BABIN: Yes.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
14 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that
15 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

16 MS. BABIN: Yes.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
18 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
19 that you are also giving up your right to appeal
20 this matter?

21 MS. BABIN: Yes.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,

1 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise
2 of a fine of \$2,000 payable in 60 days be
3 accepted. If the fine is not payable in 60 days,
4 the license will be suspended until the fine has
5 been paid.

6 Is there a second?

7 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
9 has seconded the motion.

10 All those in favor say aye.

11 ALL: Aye.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?

13 The matter passes 6-0-0.

14 Thank you very much.

15 MS. BABIN: Thank you. I think that's
16 the last for me today.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
