If the fine has not been paid -- is not 8 paid in 60 days, the license will be suspended 9 until the fine has been paid. Is this your understanding of the 10 Offer in Compromise? 11 12 MS. BABIN: Yes. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware 14 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that you are giving up your right to a hearing? 15 16 MS. BABIN: Yes. 17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also 18 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, 19 that you are also giving up your right to appeal this matter? 20 21 MS. BABIN: Yes. 22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,
