ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Administration (ABCA) has reviewed its records and determined that Booey of Georgetown Corporation, t/a Booeymonger Restaurant (Respondent), has failed to pay the second-year license fees for its license by March 31, 2023, the deadline for all Retailer's DR licenses, despite being notified by ABCA of the payment date.

Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to pay the second-year license fees for the Retailer's Class DR License. The Respondent did not respond to the Order to Cease and Desist.

However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
