ORDER APPROVING THE OFFER-IN-COMPROMISE

This matter arises from a Notice of Status and Show Cause Hearing (Notice) issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) in the matter of Booey of Georgetown Corporation, t/a Booeymonger Restaurant (Respondent), located at 3265 Prospect Street, NW, Washington, D.C. 20007.

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) served the Notice in Case No. 18-CC-00008 on the Respondent on May 9, 2018. ABRA Show Cause File No. 18-CC-00008, Notice of Status and Show Cause Hearing (May 7, 2018). The Notice charges the Respondent with a single violation, which if proven true, would justify the imposition of a fine, as well as the suspension or revocation of the Respondent's license.

Specifically, the Notice in Case No. 18-CC-00008, charged the Respondent with the following violation:

Charge I: [On Friday, February 2, 2018], [y]ou sold, deliver, or permitted the consumption of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age, in violation of D.C. Official Code § 25-781(a)(1)...

ABRA Show Cause File No. 18-CC-00008, Notice of Status Hearing and Show Cause Hearing, 2-3 (May 7, 2018).

At the Show Cause Hearing held on July 11, 2018, the Respondent and the Government entered into an Offer-in-Compromise (OIC), which resolved the charge set forth above.

The terms of the OIC are as follows:

1. For Charge I – The Respondent shall pay a \$2,000 fine for the violation alleged in Charge I and shall have its license suspended for five (5) days, with four (4) days stayed for one (1) year, and one (1) day to be served.

By agreeing to the terms of the OIC, the Respondent waives its right to a Show Cause Hearing and appeal. The OIC has been reduced to writing and is formally approved through this Order.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board, on this 11th day of July, 2018, hereby **APPROVES** the OIC proffered by the Government and the Respondent and **ORDERS** Booey of Georgetown Corporation, t/a Booeymonger Restaurant, to comply with the terms of the OIC.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent will:

- (1) Remit the fine in the total sum of \$2,000 payable on or before September 11, 2018; and
- (2) Incur a five (5) day suspension, with one (1) day to be served and four (4) days stayed for one (1) year. The one (1) day suspension will be served on July 30, 2018.

Failure to remit the amount in full within the time specified will result in the suspension of the license until the amount is paid.

A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent and to the Government.
