ORDER ON REINSTATEMENT OF APPLICATION

The Application filed by Cafe Bistro MED, LLC, t/a Cafe 8 (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer’s CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 11, 2022. On July 11, 2022, the Board dismissed the Application and the Protest of ANC 6B because the Applicant and ANC 6B failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing, which was memorialized in Board Order No. 2022-313 issue.

ANC 6B subsequently filed a letter informing the Board that their protest was filed in error, and that the ANC in fact supported the Application. In light of this additional information from the ANC, the Board hereby vacates the dismissal of the Application and reinstates the Application, which will subsequently be treated as an unopposed application pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-311 because no other person filed a protest.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board, on this 27th day of July 2022, hereby **VACATES** Board Order No. 2022-313 and **REINSTATES** the Application, which shall be deemed unopposed in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-311.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the protest of ANC 6B is deemed **WITHDRAWN**.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR

§ 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
