comment?	
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. Go ahead,	
Mr. Alberti.

my individual opinion is if you do not act	
tomorrow to cancel your license, I will oppose	
any attempt to cancel the license after that	
until this matter is settled.	
So, please, just make sure that you	
get here tomorrow.	
MR. MAALOUF: Agree, agree.	

MEMBER ALBERTI: And take care of 1 2 matters. MR. MAALOUF: I understand. 3 4 MEMBER ALBERTI: Thank you. 5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 6 With that said, then I make a motion that the 7 Offer in Compromise that the licensee will 8 surrender the license to the Agency by close of 9 business tomorrow, that that be accepted. Is there a second? 10 11 MEMBER SHORT: Second. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has 13 seconded the motion. 14 All those in favor say aye? 15 ALL: Aye. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed? 17 The matter passes 7-0-0. 18 Sir, you have heard what the Board's 19 position is that you have to surrender the license by close of business tomorrow. 20 And that 21 if that is not done, then the Agency, we are going to move forward with the charges and we are 22
