ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On July 27, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-106151 held by 5534 Connecticut, LLC, t/a Capital Crab & Seafood (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to renew its license by July 12, 2022, the extension deadline for all Retailer's Class CR licenses. *See* Board Order No. 2022-537.

On July 28, 2022, the Petitioner sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-106151. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from renew its license have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 10th day of August 2022, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on July 27, 2022, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-106151 be REINSTATED.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Cou1t of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
