Is this your understanding of the 9 offer in compromise? 10 MR. KLINE: Yes, sir, it is, Mr. 11 Chair. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 13 aware that by accepting the offer in compromise 14 that they're giving up their right to a hearing? 15 MR.
