3 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in
4 the matter of Catherine's Kitchen come -- please
5 come forward. This is case number 18-PRO-00014.
6 Catherine's Kitchen LLC, t/a Catherine's Kitchen,
7 4722 14th Street, NW, license number ABRA-108846.

8 This is a Retailer Class CR new
9 application. The protest issues are adverse
10 impact on peace order and quiet, residential
11 parking, and vehicular and pedestrian safety, and
12 real property values.

13 My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'm
14 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's
15 Agent. Introductions beginning with the
16 Applicant, please.

17 So, Mr. Denney, if you would state
18 your name and spell it for the record.

19 MR. DENNEY: Daryl Denney. That's D
20 as in David, A as in apple, R as in Robert, Y as
21 in yo-yo, L as in Lima. Denney -- D as in David,
22 E as in Edward, N as in Nancy, N as in Nancy, E

1 as in Edward, Y as in yo-yo.

2 MS. FLETCHER: And -- thank you. And
3 present on behalf of the group of five?

4 MS. IRWIN: Elisa Irwin.

5 MS. FLETCHER: And, Ms. Irwin, if you
6 would spell your name for the record?

7 MS. IRWIN: Absolutely. E-L-I-S-A
8 I-R-W-I-N.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
10 And just for the record, the ANC 4C entered into
11 a settlement agreement with the Applicant in this
12 matter, but we still have the group of -- that
13 you representing, Ms. Irwin, so there are two
14 things that need to happen this morning.

15 First, your group is granted
16 conditional standing. What that means is, if
17 there were going to be a status hearing, four
18 more people would need to appear. But, in this
19 case that won't be required, because there's not
20 going to be a status hearing.

21 The reason there's not going to be a
22 status hearing is because, pursuant to DC

1 Official Code 25609B, in the event an effective
2 ANC submits a settlement agreement to the Board
3 on a protested license application, the Board,
4 upon its approval of the settlement agreement,
5 shall dismiss any protested group of five
6 residential property owners. On March 28, 2018
7 the ABC Board approved the settlement agreement
8 between the Applicant and ANC for C. Therefore,
9 the group of protestants is dismissed in this
10 case. Any questions?

11 MR. DENNEY: No, ma'am.

12 MS. IRWIN: No.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Questions, Mr. Denney?

14 Okay. The rules -- oh, did you fill out the
15 contact information?

16 MR. DENNEY: Yes, ma'am.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very
18 much. The roll call hearing is concluded.

19 MR. DENNEY: Thank you so much.

20 MS. IRWIN: Thank you so much.
