18	an Offer in Compromise to present at this time.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is the
20	Offer in Compromise?
21	MR. RIVERO: The offer is: For Charge
22	1 a fine of \$2,500.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Could you hold your voice down, please, ma'am? We can hear you all the way up here, please. Go ahead, sir.

MR. RIVERO: For Charge 1 a fine of \$2,500 payable within 30 days. If the payment is not received within 30 days, the license will be suspended until payment is received.

For Charge 2 a warning.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

MR. RIVERO: Because the Government believes it's appropriate. The licensee had a security plan in place, but had not actually filed it, which is a requirement. And as part of the warning, the licensee will be required to file the security plan with the Board within 30 days. That is the OIC.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. All right. Ms. Yohannes, it's my understanding there is an Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that for Charge 1, there is a fine of \$2,500 payable in 30 days. If the fine is not payable in 30 days, the license will be suspended

until the fine has been paid. 1 2 For Charge 2, that there is a written And as a part of that written warning, 3 warning. 4 that the licensee will provide the Board a 5 legally sufficient security plan within the next 30 days. 6 7 Is this your understanding of the 8 Offer in Compromise? 9 MS.
