## ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF RENEWAL APPLICATION

The Application filed by Wade Road, Inc., t/a Charles Corner (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Protest Status Hearing on February 4, 2021, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On February 4, 2021, the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order 2021-074.

On February 9, 2021, Chrissie Chang, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement. Ms. Chang explained that the Applicant did not appear at the Protest Status Hearing because he was experiencing internet connection issues and therefore, he could not remain online long enough to attend the virtual hearing. Ms. Chang seeks the reinstatement of the Application so that the license can be renewed.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

## **ORDER**

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 24th day of February 2021, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Wade Road, Inc., t/a Charles Corner, for renewal of its Retailer's Class B License.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(l), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
