4 Our case is a protest hearing status case, No.
5 19-PRO-00093, Charles E. Smith Center, License
6 No. 1070. Will the parties please approach to
7 identify themselves for the record, please?
8 Let's start with the licensee.

9 MR. BLANCHARD: Good morning, Chairman
10 Anderson. My name is Lyle Blanchard of
11 Greenstein Delorme & Luchs. I'm representing the
12 applicant, George Washington University.

13 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.

5 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.
6 Sacco. Are there any preliminary matters in this
7 case? No? This matter is scheduled for a
8 protest hearing on October 30th, at 1:30. I
9 guess October 30th is going to be -- we do have
10 two protest hearings at 1:30, and we have a 4:30
11 protest hearing, so that's going to be an
12 interesting day for the Board. Now that we're
13 scheduled, do I need to go through the
14 instructions for protest hearing that I read
15 twice so far this morning?

16 MR. SACCO: I was just going to add
17 that we have, at this point, reached a settlement
18 agreement. It's just the process of getting it
19 signed.

20 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: That's wonderful
21 news, I guess. I won't have the pleasure of
22 seeing you on October 30th, at 1:30.

1 MR. SACCO: We're hoping to have it
2 submitted either today or tomorrow, I believe.

3 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Well, I thank the
4 parties for being here. And as I said, if you
5 receive a settlement -- if you sign a settlement
6 agreement, you send it to the Board for our
7 consideration. Once the Board reviews it, then
8 we will sign off on it and cancel the hearing.
9 Thank you for being here.

10 MR. SACCO: Thank you.

11 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Have a great day.
12 Thank you.
