25	went off the record at 9:52:30 a.m. and resumed



NEHMETALLAH: George Nehmetallah 8 from the Protestant. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, your 10 last name, sir? 11 MR. NEHMETALLAH: George Nehmetallah. 12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Lebettelli? 13 MR. NEHMETALLAH: Nehmetallah, Nehmetallah. 14 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, 16 sir. 17 MR. TURNER: James Turner with the ANC 18 1B. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, 20 Mr. Turner. What this means is that 12 the Board will dismiss the renewal application 13 for this establishment. They will be given 10 14 days to provide the Board with reasonable notice 15 why they failed to appear today.
