MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. 6 7 There are five people present from your group 8 today which means that your group is granted 9 standing today. 10 When you appear for the upcoming 11 status hearing, only you need to appear since 12 you've been granted standing already. 13 I'm going to give you a date for a 14 mediation, a status hearing and a protest 15 hearing. 3	hearing is concluded.
