ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) previously cancelled the license held by 2718 Corporation, t/a Chuck & Bill Bison Lounge (Licensee), located at 2718 Georgia Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C., because the ownership failed to renew. The Board is aware that the owner previously died. Subsequently, the owner's son, Ty Gary (Petitioner) has filed for the reinstatement of the license. Nevertheless, the Petitioner has not taken any steps to formally transfer the license. As such, the Petitioner lacks standing to request the reinstatement of the license at this time. The Board advises the Petitioner to review D.C. Official Code § 25-361 and file for an involuntary transfer of the license. Until such time, the Petitioner's request to reinstate the license shall be denied, and the Cease and Desist Order issued on March 18, 2020 shall remain in effect.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board, on this 16th day of September 2020, hereby **DENIES** the motion for reinstatement filed by the Petitioner.

Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thilty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E StTeet, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
