5	The parties in the matter of Navy Yard.
6	DR. FARLEE: You should sit over
7	there.
8	AGENT FLETCHER: This is Case No. 18-
9	PRO-00068, MHG Navy Yard, LLC t/a Circa at Navy
10	Yard. What's the last part of that, El what?
11	MS. BARTA: El Bebe.
12	AGENT FLETCHER: El Bebe, 99 M Street,
13	S.E., License No. ABRA-109955. This is a
14	Retailer Class CR new application.
15	The protest issues are adverse impact

7	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay.
8	DR. FARLEE: that had to do with
9	the sidewalk cafe space.
10	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. That's fine.
11	Are you in agreement with that, Ms. Barta?
12	MS. BARTA: Yes.
13	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. So we won't
14	schedule the mediation. I'm just going to make a
15	note that you believe it's not going to be
16	necessary, so I'm going to make a note.
17	DR. FARLEE: But you were going to
18	protect propose a Status Hearing as well?
19	AGENT FLETCHER: I'm going to give you
20	the date for the Status and Protest Hearing
21	dates, because I have to.
22	DR. FARLEE: Well, the status the

1	Protest Hearing is already listed.
2	AGENT FLETCHER: It's already listed.
3	I'm going to give it to you anyway.
4	DR. FARLEE: On the placard.
5	AGENT FLETCHER: Yeah, the Protest
6	Hearing is on the Placard Notice, but I'm going
7	to give it to you again today, that date will not
8	have changed. But I
9	MS. BARTA: It ended last week I
10	believe.
11	AGENT FLETCHER: I'm talking about
12	DR. FARLEE: November 28.
13	AGENT FLETCHER: I'm talking about the
14	protest date.
15	MS. BARTA: Oh, okay.
16	DR. FARLEE: November 28 is on the
17	Protest Placard.
18	AGENT FLETCHER: Yeah, so that date is
19	already
20	DR. FARLEE: Yes.
21	AGENT FLETCHER: Dr. Farlee is
22	correct. That date is on the Placard Notice.

1	I'm just going to restate it just for the record
2	today.
3	So I made a note that mediation is not
4	necessary, Dr. Farlee, for the reason that you
5	both just stated.
6	I'll give you the date for the Status
7	Hearing. The Status Hearing is scheduled for
8	October 31st at 9:30 a.m., but if you submit that
9	settlement agreement before then, we will cancel
10	that.
11	DR. FARLEE: Yes. October 31, you
12	said?
13	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes, October 31 at
14	9:30.
15	DR. FARLEE: Um-hum.
16	AGENT FLETCHER: The day for the
17	Protest Hearing is November 28th.
18	DR. FARLEE: Right.
19	AGENT FLETCHER: November 28 at 4:30.
20	DR. FARLEE: We desperately hope we
21	won't get that far.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay.

1	DR. FARLEE: So I think our option is,
2	what is being negotiated is the one of the
3	sidewalk cafes.
4	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.
5	DR. FARLEE: One option is just to
6	leave it out and make an amendment to the
7	agreement if there is any change.
8	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.
9	DR. FARLEE: Or when there is a final
10	decision about it.
11	AGENT FLETCHER: That's true.
12	DR. FARLEE: So we can get something
13	through for the October 15 meeting.
14	AGENT FLETCHER: Exactly. Well, any
15	questions at all? Any questions at all, Ms.
16	Barta?
17	MS. BARTA: No.
18	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Well, the Roll
19	Call Hearing is concluded. Thank you for coming.
20	DR. FARLEE: Thank you, LaVerne.
