6	Will the parties, please, approach and
7	identify themselves for the record, please?
8	MR. WOODSON: Good morning, Chairman
9	Anderson.
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Roderic
12	Woodson, a partner at Holland & Knight, counsel
13	for Cloakroom. Greetings to the Board this
14	morning.
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
16	Mr. Woodson.
17	MR. DeMOYA: Good morning. Andre
18	DeMoya, owner of Cloakroom.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
20	Mr. DeMoya.
21	Is there anyone here from the group to
22	protest this matter?

	This matter was it's my
2	understanding that the group was granted
3	conditional standing at the Roll Call Hearing and
4	four members were supposed to have shown up this
5	morning and no one is here.
6	This matter was scheduled for a 9:30
7	hearing. It's now 10:04 and the party is not
8	here. So therefore, I'm going to make a motion
9	that the Group of Five or More be dismissed. Is
10	there a second?
11	MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein
13	has seconded the motion.
14	MR. WOODSON: Mr. Chairman, may I
15	speak before the Board rules?
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes. Yes, sir.
17	MR. WOODSON: All right. We were here
18	for the Roll Call.
19	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, sir.
20	MR. WOODSON: There was one individual
21	who was present
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, sir.

MR. WOODSON: -- to keep us informed, at that time, that the Group of Five or More had to appear in-person in order for the protest to be granted standing.

This is the second time this has happened. And this is the second time for their failure to appear even having received written notice from the Board that their appearance was required.

As the Board considers your Motion to Dismiss, I ask that that motion be dismiss to be one with prejudice, because the parties have had an ample opportunity to appear and there is-give those three occasions for failure to appear and affect their protest, I ask that the Board conclude this matter, that the matter be dismissed with prejudice. Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, Mr. Woodson. I'm not sure if I can do that from the -- the Board can do that from the Bench today, but I know that, as you are aware, that we will issue a decision within 10 days and they would

have to provide us just cause why is it that they 1 2 were not here today. And based on the arguments that you 3 4 are making today, unless they can rebut that, I 5 don't see how the Board would rule otherwise. So Mr. Silverstein has -- who had 6 7 seconded the motion? 8 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I did. 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Silverstein has seconded the motion. 10 11 All those in favor say aye. 12 ALL: Aye. 13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed? The matter passes 5-0-0. 14 15 We have now dismissed the Group of 16 Five or More. They will be given -- a written 17 order will be issued. They have 10 days to 18 appeal that order. And if they do not appeal the 19 order in 10 days, then your license, sir, will be renewed with whatever conditions that were --20 21 that is currently on the license. No new

conditions will be imposed.
