ORDER VACATING CANCELATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On November 18, 2020, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class CT License No. ABRA-093572 held by KAT, LLC, t/a Cloud Restaurant & Lounge Sports Bar, because KAT, LLC failed to pay the second year license fees. *See* Board Order No. 2020-813.

On November 23, 2020, Tesfit Kiflu, on behalf of KAT, LLC (Petitioner), sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CT License No. ABRA-093572. In support of his request for reinstatement, Mr. Kiflu stated that he did not receive proper notice from the Board requesting to pay the second year license fees for his license.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner pays the second year license fees.

Accordingly, it is this 24th day of November 2020, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against KAT, LLC, t/a Cloud Restaurant & Lounge Sports Bar, by the Board on November 18, 2020, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.

Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thilty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E StTeet, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion.
