## **ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION**

The above-mentioned parties appeared before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board on March 23, 2022. At the hearing, the parties proposed an offer-in-compromise (OIC) to resolve the enforcement action described in the cases identified above, which was approved by the Board in Board Order No. 2022-120 on March 30, 2022. After the approval of the OIC, the Applicant has subsequently demonstrated compliance with all terms and conditions needed to lift the suspension and to authorize the return the license.

## **ORDER**

Therefore, on this 6th day of April 2022, the Board **LIFTS** the suspension of the license and authorizes the return of the license to the Respondent. The ABRA shall deliver copies of this Order to the Government and the Respondent.

Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, N.W., 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009. Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, District of Columbia Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule

15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b).

Finally, in the case of a summary suspension, "A person aggrieved by a final summary action may file an appeal in accordance with the procedures set forth in subchapter I of Chapter 5 of Title 2." D.C. Code § 25-826(d).
