ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTESTS

The Application filed by Creole on 14th, LLC, t/a Creole on 14th, for a Substantial Change to change its hours of operation and add dancing and cover charge to its Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on October 18, 2021, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On October 18, 2021, the Board dismissed the Protests of GALA Hispanic Theatre and Tivoli Partners Commercial, LLC.

GALA Hispanic Theatre's Protest was dismissed because 1) it failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing, and 2) it did not claim to be an abutting property owner. D.C. Official Code § 25-601(1)(A) and 23 DCMR § 1603.4.

Tivoli Partners Commercial, LLC's Protest was dismissed because 1) it did not claim to be an abutting property owner, and 2) its protest letter was not signed by the protestant. D.C. Official Code § 25-601 and 23 DCMR § 1602.3.

GALA Hispanic Theatre and Tivoli Partners Commercial, LLC may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

ORDER

The Board does hereby this 20th day of October 2021, **DISMISS** the Protests of GALA Hispanic Theatre and Tivoli Partners Commercial, LLC. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Parties.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Cou1t of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
