**ORDER ON SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND  
WITHDRAWAL OF ANC 6A'S PROTEST**

The Application filed by Capitol Square Bar and Grill Limited Liability Company, t/a DC Capitol Square Bar & Grill (Applicant), for a new Retailer's Class CR License, was protested by ANC 6A.

The official records of the Board reflect that the Applicant and ANC 6A entered into a Settlement Agreement (Agreement), dated August 10, 2021, that governs the operations of the Applicant's establishment.

The Agreement has been reduced to writing and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. The Applicant and Commissioner Brian Alcorn, on behalf of ANC 6A, are signatories to the Agreement.

This Agreement constitutes a withdrawal of the Protest filed by ANC 6A.

Accordingly, it is this 18th day of August 2021, **ORDERED** that:

1. The Application filed by Capitol Square Bar and Grill Limited Liability Company, t/a DC Capitol Square Bar & Grill, for a new Retailer's Class CR License, located at 1500 East Capitol Street, NE, Washington, D.C., is **GRANTED**;
2. The Protest of ANC 6A in this matter is hereby **WITHDRAWN**;
3. The above-referenced Settlement Agreement submitted by the parties to govern the operations of the Applicant's establishment is **APPROVED** and **INCORPORATED** as part of this Order; and
4. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and ANC 6A.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
