## ORDER DENYING PROTESTANT'S MOTION FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by DC Market, Inc., t/a DC Food Market (Applicant), for a substantial change to its Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 18, 2022. At the hearing, the Protestant Group was dismissed for failing to file a protest in accordance with 23 DCMR § 1602.3. Subsequently, the Protestant Group filed a motion for reconsideration, which is opposed by the Applicant.

The Board notes that the motion did not address the reason for the dismissal. It should be further noted that to the extent the response constitutes a new protest letter, it is untimely. Consequently, there are no valid grounds for reinstating the protest.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
