3 CHAIR ANDERSON: All right. The next
4 case on our show cause hearing status calendar is
5 Case Number 19-AUD-00045, DC Harvest, License
6 Number 93867. Would the parties please approach
7 and identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MR. LUI: Good morning, John Lui on
9 behalf of the District of Columbia.

10 CHAIR ANDERSON: Good morning again,
11 Mr. Lui.

12 MR. RINGEL: My name is Jared Ringel,
13 I'm one of the owners of DC Harvest.

14 CHAIR ANDERSON: You said Ringel?

15 MR. RINGEL: Ringel --

16 CHAIR ANDERSON: What's your last --

17 MR. RINGEL: -- R-I-N-G-E-L.

18 CHAIR ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.
19 Ringel.

20 MR. RINGEL: Good morning.

21 CHAIR ANDERSON: Are there preliminary
22 matters in this case?

23 MR. LUI: Yes. This is an offer in
24 compromise to present to the Board.

25 CHAIR ANDERSON: And what is the offer

1 in compromise, please?

2 MR. LUI: The offer in compromise is
3 for Charge 1, the failure to keep and maintain
4 books and records for a period of three years,
5 this is a primary tier violation. The offer in
6 compromise is a \$1,250 fine, made payable within
7 30 days or its license shall be suspended
8 indefinitely until this fine is paid.

9 CHAIR ANDERSON: Thank you. Mr.
10 Ringel, it is my understanding that there is an
11 offer in compromise. And the offer in compromise
12 is that there is a fine of \$1,250 payable in 30
13 days. If the fine is not paid within 30 days,
14 the license will be suspended until the fine has
15 been paid. Is this your understanding of the
16 offer in compromise?

17 MR. RINGEL: Yes.

18 CHAIR ANDERSON: Are you aware that by
19 accepting an offer in compromise, that you're
20 giving up your right to a hearing?

21 MR. RINGEL: Yes.

22 CHAIR ANDERSON: Are you also aware
23 that by accepting an offer in compromise, that
24 you're giving up your right to appeal this
25 matter?

1 MR. RINGEL: Yes.

2 CHAIR ANDERSON: With that said, I make
3 a motion that the offer in compromise of a fine
4 of \$1,250 payable in 30 days. If the fine is not
5 paid within 30 days, the license will be
6 suspended until the fine has been paid. Is there
7 a second?

8 MEMBER CROCKETT: Second.

9 CHAIR ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has
10 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
11 aye.

12 (Chorus of ayes.)

13 CHAIR ANDERSON: Those opposed? The
14 matter passes, 5-0-0.

15 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
16 went off the record at 10:06 a.m.)
