The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in the Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson, presiding.

3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4	on our calendar is Case No. 17-CC-00100, Dacha
5	Beer Garden, License No. 92773.
6	Will the parties, please, approach and
7	identify themselves for the record, please?
8	MS. SCHMIDT: Good morning, Amy
9	Schmidt, Assistant Attorney General on behalf of
10	the District of Columbia.
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Schmidt.
12	MS. YOHANNES: Good afternoon, Sidon
13	Yohannes on behalf of the licensee.
14	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
15	Ms. Yohannes.
16	Are there any preliminary matters in
17	this case?
18	MS. SCHMIDT: Yes, there are. Yes,
19	there is. There is an Offer in Compromise in
20	this case and the Offer in Compromise consists of
21	for Charge 1, sale to a minor, a \$3,000 fine to
22	be paid within 30 days or its license shall be

suspended indefinitely until this fine is paid.

And the license shall be suspended for five days with all five days stayed for one year. And all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in the licensed establishment complete an alcohol training program within 3 months from the OIC's date.

Charge 2 will be dismissed. But I would like to speak about this OIC before we proceed.

The District realizes this is a very serious charge, sale to a minor, in this establishment. And I would also like to point out that it did give the maximum fine for Charge 1, but this is a -- and Charge 2 was dismissed because upon review of the evidence, we saw that the bartender -- I'm sorry, the bouncer did check the ID and it has been the policy of this Board not to proceed if the ID has been checked.

However, nevertheless, given the fact
-- even though there is a separate statutory
scheme for 781 as -- it doesn't count as the

fourth primary for this violation. However, it will count as a fourth violation in the future, fourth primary violation in the future. So the establishment should be on notice that they -- that next time they are facing revocation, if there is a next time.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Ms. Yohannes, it's my understanding that there is an Offer in Compromise and for Charge 1, there is a \$3,000 fine payable in 30 days. There is also five days suspension for one year and all five days are stayed. And that all employees who serve or sell alcohol will undergo training within 90 days.

And that for Charge 2, a written warning will be issued.

MS. SCHMIDT: I'm sorry, we are dropping Charge 2. Charge 2 is being dropped.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh, it's been dropped, not a warning. Okay. And that for charge -- all right. And that the Government is dismissing Charge 2.

Is this your understanding of the Offer in Compromise?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes, it is.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And does -- is your client aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that they are giving up their right to a hearing?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And that they are -- does your client also understand that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that they are giving up their right to appeal this matter?

MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Are there any questions by any Board Members?

Hearing none, I make a motion that the Offer in Compromise of a fine of \$3,000 payable in 30 days, that there will be a five -- there is a five day suspension for one year and all five days will -- a five day suspension and all five days will be stayed for one year. And that all employees who sell or serve alcohol will go --
