13	the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's Agent.
14	Introductions beginning with the
15	applicant, please. If you would just state your
16	name and spell the applicant.
17	Where is the representative for Deset
18	Ethiopian Restaurant?
19	MR. WILLIAMS: Yes. My name is Larry
20	Williams, member of the Bar of the District of
21	Columbia. I'll be representing Deset Restaurant.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. Williams, okay,

1 Larry Williams? 2 MR. WILLIAMS: Larry Williams. Okay. Thank you very 3 AGENT FLETCHER: 4 much. 5 MR. WILLIAMS: Um-hum. And your name, ma'am? 6 AGENT FLETCHER: 7 If you could spell it and state it? 8 MS. SERBESSA: My name is Emebet, E-M-9 E-B-E-T. 10 AGENT FLETCHER: I'm sorry, what was 11 that? 12 MS. SERBESSA: E-M-E-B-E-T. 13 AGENT FLETCHER: E-M-E? 14 MS. SERBESSA: B-E-T. 15 AGENT FLETCHER: And is that the last 16 name? 17 MS.
