I remind everyone, seven days before the hearing, if the matter is not settled, seven days before the hearing, you're supposed to exchange documents and witnesses with both sides and with the Agency.

And just as a -- if you need some guidance in the process, please contact Ms. April Randall at 202-442-4353 and she will provide both sides with any assistance they made in making sure that the documents are provided, are exchanged to both sides and also provided to the Board.

I wish you both good luck in continued talk. I have always told parties, I never take it personally if you don't come back for a hearing. It tells me that you have worked it out. But if not, I will see you in the new year.

MS. NELSON: Yes, things have been much better since they've brought Mr. Hunter on board, communications have opened up. So, it is the ANC's hope that we will be able to get a settlement agreement in place prior to the 15th.

CHAIR ANDERSON: Thank you, and good luck. Good luck in your negotiations.
