3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4 on our calendar is Case No. 19-CMP-00011, Dirty
5 Martini Inn Bar/Dirty Bar, License No. 83919.

6 Would the parties approach and
7 identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board
9 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of
10 Columbia.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
12 Mr. Rivero.

13 MR. REHMAN: Good morning. Michael
14 Rehman from Dirty Martini.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
16 Mr. -- I'm sorry, your last -- pronounce your
17 last name again for me.

18 MR. REHMAN: Rehman.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Rehman?

20 MR. REHMAN: Yes.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,
22 sir. All right. Are there any preliminary

1 matters in this case?

2 MR. RIVERO: Yes. The parties have an
3 Offer in Compromise to present to the Board, at
4 this time.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is
6 that, sir?

7 MR. RIVERO: The Offer in Compromise
8 consists of a fine of \$4,500 payable within 90
9 days. If the payment is not made within 90 days,
10 the license is suspended until the payment is
11 received. That is the Offer in Compromise.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Mr.
13 Rehman, it's my understanding that there is an
14 Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise
15 is a fine of \$4,500 payable in 90 days. If the
16 fine is not payable in 90 days, the license will
17 be suspended until the fine has been paid.

18 Is this your understanding of the
19 Offer in Compromise?

20 MR. REHMAN: Yes, sir.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
22 that by accepting an Offer in Compromise, that

1 you are giving up your right to a hearing?

2 MR. REHMAN: Yes.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
4 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,
5 that you are giving up your right to appeal this
6 matter?

7 MR. REHMAN: Yes.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With that said,
9 I make a motion that the Offer in Compromise of a
10 fine of \$4,500 payable in 90 days be accepted.
11 If the fine is not payable in 90 days, the
12 license will be suspended until the fine has been
13 paid. Is there a second?

14 MEMBER CATO: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato has
16 seconded the motion.

17 All those in favor say aye.

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?

20 The matter passes 4-0-0.

21 Thank you very much for having signed-
22 off on this.

1 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Chairman, I would
2 like to --

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Hold on. The
4 matter passes 4-0-0. You have a question. Mr.
5 Short has a question that he wants to ask.

6 MEMBER SHORT: Yes, I would like to
7 know is this business still operating?

8 MR. REHMAN: Yes.

9 MEMBER SHORT: Do you have all your
10 licenses?

11 MR. REHMAN: Yes.

12 MEMBER SHORT: All of them?

13 MR. REHMAN: Yes, yes.

14 MEMBER SHORT: Okay. Thank you. I
15 just wanted to ask that question.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We will have
17 you sign-off on this Board Order -- I'm sorry,
18 the OIC cover sheet. Thank you.
