ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND REINSTATING LICENSE

On May 12, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class A License No. ABRA-102521 held by District Still, LLC, t/a District Still (Petitioner), because the Petitioner failed to renew its license. *See* Board Order No. 2021-270.

On August 9, 2021, Richard J. Bianco, Esq., on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class A License No. ABRA-102521. In support of its request for reinstatement, the Petitioner indicated that all issues preventing the Petitioner from renew its license have been resolved.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper conditioned upon the requirement that the Petitioner submits the renewal application and pays the license fees.

Accordingly, it is this 11th day of August 2021, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on May 12, 2021, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that its Retailer's Class A License ABRA-102521 be **REINSTATED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Petitioner submit the renewal application and pay the required fees within two (2) weeks from the date of this Order.



Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
