ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

In Board Order No. 2020-226, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) extended the protest deadline in the matter of the Application filed by EZRA S, Inc., t/a Dix Market, (Applicant) to June 15, 2020, for the purpose of allowing Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 7C to vote on the issue of protesting the Application, which is permitted in accordance with 23 DCMR § 1705.5. No petition was received by the protest petition deadline, which is required pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-602(a). The ANC eventually filed a protest on June 18, 2020, three days after the extended deadline. As a result, the ANC's protest was rejected as untimely.

The ANC then filed a Motion for Reconsideration on June 24, 2020, asserting that it failed to file a timely protest petition due to a computer problem, electrical issues, and other problems related to COVID 19. The Applicant filed an opposition to the motion, and the ANC filed a subsequent reply which was also untimely filed.

Nevertheless, the Board does not have the discretion or the authority to further extend the protest petition deadline. Moreover, alternative means of submitting the protest letter were available. Therefore, on this 8th day of July 2020, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) **DENIES** the Motion for Reconsideration filed by the ANC. A copy of this Order shall be provided to the parties.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code§ 25-433(d)(l), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thilty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E StTeet, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
