The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Jamie T. Carrillo, t/a Don Jaime (Respondent), has failed to renew its Retailer's Class CT License No. ABRA-021925. Specifically, the Respondent failed to renew its license by September 30, 2022, the deadline for all Retailer's Class CT licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date.

On October 19, 2022, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against the Respondent, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class CT License. The Respondent did not respond to the Order to Cease and Desist. *See* Board Order No. 2022-737.
